This regal appellation is renowned for its minerality and structure. Aged in 30% new oak barrels, this is a big, rich wine, with a dose of white pepper on the nose, seductive ripe black fruits but with a tremendous underlying power. There is creaminess to the mouthfeel as well as a touch of spice. A wine of power but also finesse.

Located in the village of Savigny-les-Beaune, just to the north of Beaune proper, the Camus fashion beautifully balanced, deep and complex wines that are the epitome of what great Burgundy is all about. The family has a lovely spread of top vineyards in Savigny-les-Beaune (both superb premier crus and a handful of top village wine parcels planted with very old pinot noir vines), as well as a bit of premier cru in Beaune and Pommard as well.</p>
