Vinification	The vineyard lies directly to the west of Beaune township, on gently sloping vineyards of clay, lime and ironstone. The vineyard lies directly below the 1er crus of Greves and Cent Vignes. All grapes are hand picked in small baskets. Fermented and aged in a mixture of both French, American and Hungarian oak of which 33% is new. No filtration, just racking twice before bottling
