The family House of Billecart Salmon is one of the few remaining Champagne houses to be owned by the original founding family and was established in 1818 by Nicolas-François Billecart. They continue to make rich and complex wines from their series of small family holdings throughout the Marne and Montagne de Reims regions.

Tasting Notes:

The pink colour is derived from the addition of 7% red wine added to the blend before the second fermentation in bottle. Delicate salmon pink colour. A complex nose of crushed strawberry and herbal raspberry, balanced with notes of toasted brioche and nougat.
