Flavie was Fabrice Amiot's Great Grandmother! Fortunately, the vineyards were less affected by the frost and snow, being lower in front of the village and being more North East facing. Tasted blind, you would think you are drinking Chassagne-Montrachet!

Tasting Notes:

The Bouquet is intense, revealing pink grapefruit, hint of vegetal, cream and roasted nut. The palate is fresh, intense, immense! The attack of citrus fruits, lime, grapefruit and buttered apple are an assault on the senses. The tight structure, intense minerality and steely acidity melt away to reveal sweet peach, nut, spice, cream and a touch of oak. The finish is very long. Is this really just a Bourgogne AOC?! Tasted blind, you would think you are drinking Chassagne-Montrachet!
