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## Bourgogne Pinot Noir 2022, Domaine Voillot

Produced from 3 plots, Les Long Bois and Les Grandes Terres, covering approximately 1.3 hectares, the vineyards are situated on the lower slopes in the village of Volnay, with vines that average 60 years old.

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### Tasting Notes:

A wonderful example of cool climate Pinot Noir, Etienne started picking these grapes on 27th August. The bouquet is fragrant, with aromas of black fruits and a refreshing whiff of wild hedgerow.

The palate is intense with notes of confit jam, a touch of liquorice and soft charming tannins.

<b>Vinification</b>	Hand-picked, with average vine age of 40-60 years, Pigeage is done by hand, starting at twice a day for the first 6 days, then 1 a day thereafter. A maturation for 9 months in 1-4 year old barrels follows. 20% new oak.
