Theo Merlin is now chief winemaker at this top family estate, and the wines continue to be made organically with little intervention. Theo Merlin uses more whole bunch than his father, Olivier, and here it shows – the ripeness and lush quality of the fruit shines through wonderfully

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### **Tasting Notes:**

Delicious black fruits, forward and intense ins tyle, with notes of raspberry that add freshness. The fruit is layered with supple tannins and has a real gloss to it. An incredibly complex and satisfying Pinot.

<b>Vinification</b>	Theo layers destemmed and whole bunches in the fermentation vats and uses no hand pressing, just very gentle pump overs to extract supple tannins and the richest fruit he can, with the wine seeing 15 days maceration on skins before 1 year in large oak barrels.
