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## Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru Les Macherelles 2023, Domaine Guy Amiot et Fils 6 x 75cl

This larger vineyard, planted in 1983, lies directly beneath Vergers and gently slopes to the upper reaches of the village and across to the boundary with Puligny and Bienvenues-Bâtard-Montrachet. Amiot owns a 0.5 plot of clay dominant soil which helps retain a softer, more opulent style of Chassagne. Exposure is North East and the vines are 50 years old.

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### Tasting Notes:

Known as the La Femme Classique of Chassagne this is a big, rich, concentrated, opulent wine, with a lovely density of ripe peach, apple and honeyed fruit, supported by 25% new oak.
