The wines of this domaine age particularly well, largely due to the serious acidity and minerality that so epitomise them when tasting from barrel.

Tasting Notes:

Produced from 65 year old vines, just above Vergers, that enjoy a North-East exposure and hence a longer ripening period. Vergers means "orchard" so the appley characters are most apt. A very aromatic bouquet boasting intense ripe apple aromas. The palate follows suit, rich in nougat and honey flavours and supported by a racy minerality. This is such a decadent wine.
