The wines of this domaine age particularly well, largely due to the serious acidity and minerality that so epitomise them when tasting from barrel.

Tasting Notes:

This wine is produced from 12 different parcels totaling 1ha from vines aged between 20 and 90 years old. Aged in 25% new oak for 12 months followed by 6 months in cuve. Scrumptious! A mouthfilling richness with elements of nougat, pineapple and pain grillé. The underlying acidity is bracing and produces a perfect equilibrium. Great length too.
