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## Chassagne-Montrachet Vieilles Vignes Rouge 2022, Domaine Guy Amiot

Harvested from 2ha of vines from 12 different parcels, whose exposure varies from North East to South West, planted with vines that are between 55-75 years of age. An elegant and balanced Pinot Noir, well structured, a fine tannin structure, good acidity and a long fragrant finish.

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### Tasting Notes:

Pretty colour, ruby core, the fruit is very much to the fore on the nose, almost stewed red fruits, with a hint of herbal freshness. The palate is rounded, generous and fruit-driven initially, a touch of raspberry and mulled cherry. Then the tannins kick in, the wine tightening and showing grip, structure and stony minerality. A hint of menthol is a nod toward the limestone soil. The impression is of a generous, elegant and balanced Pinot, well structured, a fine tannin structure, good acidity and a long fragrant finish.
