Harvested from 2ha of vines from 12 different parcels, whose exposure varies from North East to South West, planted with vines that are between 55-75 years of age. An elegant and balanced Pinot Noir, well structured, a fine tannin structure, good acidity and a long fragrant finish.

Tasting Notes:

I love the red wine from this appellation which is more noted for its white wines. Value for money or what! Compact and rich in strawberry and mulled cherry with a touch of hedgerow, this is classic Pinot Noir. Stony minerality and finely grained tannins add dimension. Delicious!
