One of the jewels of the Castéja family and the Borie-Manoux firm, the name of this estate comes from the word 'bataille', meaning battle, in memory of the skirmish that took place in the vineyards in 1453 during the Hundred year war.



Tasting Notes:

A ripe and powerful claret, showing the benefit of investment in both vineyard and cellars. Dark and dense in colour, slightly oily on the rim. The bouquet is forward, very ripe and sweet, with notes of red cherry, raspberry coulis and a hint of dark chocolate. The tannins are muscular without being gripping, and support the sweetly ripe fruit, all cut through with a fresh acidity and spice. Overall this is a wonderfully balanced, fresh and elegant Pauillac that shows a degree of opulence that is missing from others.
