Château Beychevelle's vineyards are located in the far south of the St-Julien appellation. It has the reputation of producing generally forward wine, supple and rich, which gives approachable, early drinking pleasure.

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### Tasting Notes:

"the 2010 Beychevelle displays sweet black currant, black cherry, foresty notes, medium to full-bodied texture with impressive purity and moderately high tannins (although they've softened considerably during the wine's upbringing in barrel). Layered and rich for a Beychevelle, this wine should easily withstand three decades of cellaring." Robert Parker, Wine Advocate #205 Feb 2013
