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## Château Clément-Pichon 2022, Haut-Médoc

Situated in Parempuyre in the southern Medoc, this 25 ha property dates back to the 14th century. Now in the ownership Clément Fayat, who also owns Château La Dominique in St Emilion, considerable investment has been made and the quality of wine produced is exceptional.

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### Tasting Notes:

Clement-Pichon 2022 displays wonderful succulent, almost lushly sweet fruit, quite fat in style, and layered with raspberry coulis, boiled black currant, vanilla and some earthy, menthol and chalk characters. Lovely rounded, elegant style, more muscular than previous vintages but definitely a wine to enjoy in 4-10 years.
