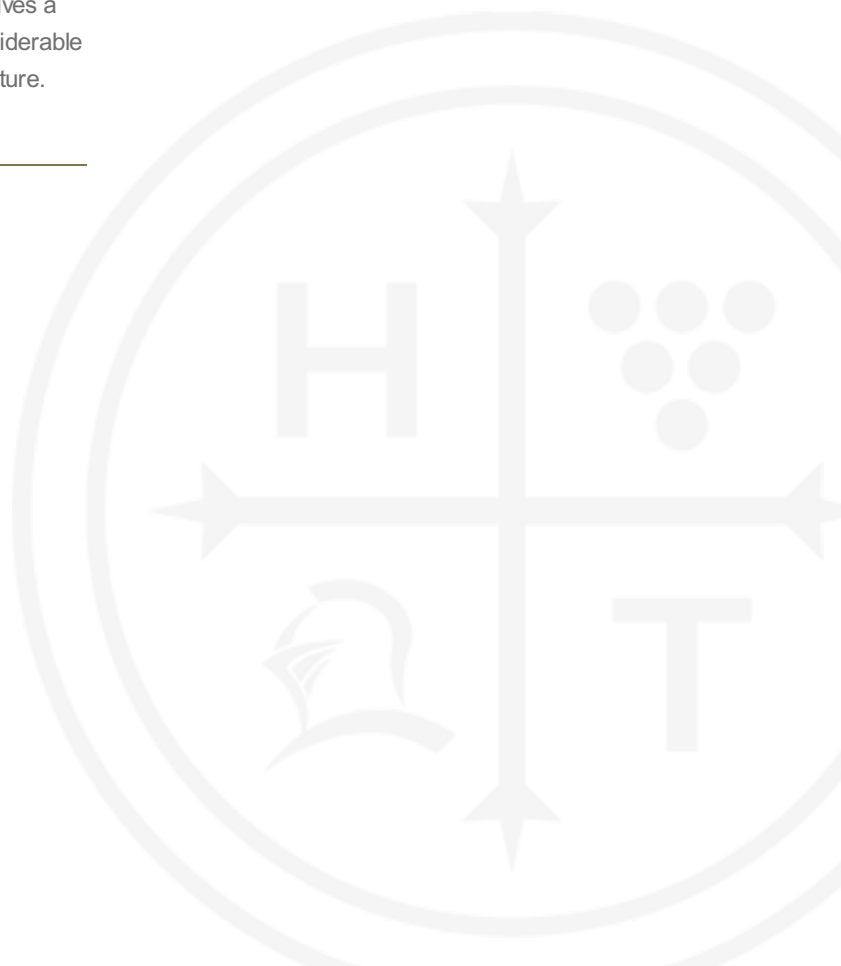
Part of the Mouton-Rothschild stable, this is a perfectly positioned Pauillac estate, neighbouring both Mouton and Lafite. Always a canny buy!

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### Tasting Notes:

A big, dark and muscular Pauillac, showing hints of raspberry, pomegranate over a core of dense cassis and sweet lack cherry fruit. An enigmatic note of bruised apple and forest floor gives a lovely counterpoint to the black fruit, and the tannins, considerable that they are, show elegance and a roundness to the structure. Very good - classic Pauillac!
