### Tasting Notes:

This is the first vintage that Jacques Rameaud has introduced Malbec into the blend. Aged in 60% old barrels and 40% in tank. This is a fabulous, rich Corbin packed with black fruits, over a rich underlay of stewed prunes and ripe plums. The tannin structure is very impressive, ripe but sturdy, and the finish impressive. Undoubtedly one of the best valued wines in our 2020 En Primeur offering.

<b>Vinification</b>	Chateau Corbin is owned and run by Jacques Ramebaud and his family, and sits on a hill looking towards Cheval Blanc and St Emilion on one aspect, and Pomerol on the other. The soil is mainly clay and limestone with some sand and gravel to the north. Yield is 55HL/Ha, all hand picked and sorted at the winery using density sorting. 40% aged in 300lits oak foudres ,60% aged in concrete tanks with 20-25% new oak most years.
