Tasting Notes:

Dark, dense and smoky, this is a rich and muscular Pauillac that shows sinew and spice. The bouquet is forward and quite intense, offering dark chocolate, cassis, blackberry and some raspberry to freshen. There is spice aplenty, an earthy dusty quality to the tannins yet the impression is of a richly sweet and well structured Pauillac that will age well. Produced by the Château Lafite winemaking team.
