Very much on top form under the watchful eye of Alexander Van Beek, this is a very impressive Margaux property that produces wonderful, harmonious wines.

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#### Tasting Notes:

Aromatic, concentrated and yet fresh bouquet. There is lovely sweet, open black fruit, spiced with a note of fresh Scottish raspberry. This is aromatic, concentrated and powerful. Very attractive! The palate opens with a thick black fruit quality that then opens to reveal notes of dried herbs, coffee and elderberry. It softens mid palate and shows great subtlety, polish and elegance. A degree of cedar and minerality on the finish seems to lift the whole wine onto a different level. Wow!
