A Growth Claret in all but name, created in the 1950's from vineyards purchased from other classed Growths. A consistent top performer in St Julien.

Tasting Notes:

This is Classed Growth St Julien in all but name. A charming and pretty bouquet yet showing a smouldering underlying power. The palate is intense and powerful, creamy in texture with ripe sweet red fruits supported by savoury capsicum and a trace of dark chocolate. The tannins are finely integrated into the core of the wine and the finish is tight and laden with spice.
