Big and powerful with notable extraction. Very much 'where Bordeaux meets the Napa Valley!'

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### Tasting Notes:

Very dark in colour, the bouquet is opulent (no surprise!) and rich in fruit aromas. Layer after layer of rich and ripe fruits dominate the palate, the tannins are super ripe and the finish quite hedonistic.
