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## Château Langoa Barton 2017, 3ème Cru Classé Saint-Julien

This 20 hectare estate is the 'sister' to Léoville Barton and in recent years has come out of its shadow.

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### Tasting Notes:

A classic Langoa, this property is no longer in the shadow of the more illustrious Leoville. Deep purple in colour and full of cassis aromas with a smattering of cedar oak. The palate is tight and a little angular at the moment, but will soften with age. Medium to full bodied with ripe cassis, finely integrated tannins and a touch of pencil lead.
