Owned by Sylvie and Jacques Guinaudeau who also own Château Lafleur, this 9 ha estate produces a wonderful deep and complex style of wine which is very much on an upward trend.

Tasting Notes:

A ripe and sumptuous Pomerol that encapsulates the elegance and fruit of the 2023 vintage. 95% Merlot and 5% Cabernet Franc, this is a Le Gay that will age well, offering rich lush black fruits, a hint of mulling spice, opulent and firming tannins that are a framework for the fruit. Touches of red cherry and raspberry coulis add freshness and focus to the black fruits, with a trace of liquorice on the finish.
