One of the finest châteaux in St. Julien, Leoville Barton has been in the hands of the Barton family since 1826. Interestingly there is actually no Château, with the wine being made at the family's sister Château Langoa Barton. The 48 hectares of vines are located in the east of the appellation and are planted with 72% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot and 8% Cabernet Franc.

Tasting Notes:

A blend of 85% Cabernet Sauvignon and 15% Merlot from a difficult vintage but this is a great surprise - deep purple, excellent chewy fruit with finely grained tannins and overtones of cassis. This will drink very early whilst you wait for the greater vintages to develop.
