One of the finest 'Super Second' growths of the Medoc, and in many eyes is worthy of First Growth status. Close to the border between St Julien and Pauillac, it is situated just next to Château Latour, and for this reason the wine is as much Pauillac in its expression, as it is of its own appellation, St Julien.

Tasting Notes:

The bouquet is quite regal. Serious and smouldering, there is a great concentration of black Cabernet fruit and taut graphite on the bouquet. The palate is complex – cassis, black cherry and liquorice with finely integrated tannins, pencil lead and stony minerality. Pure and precise, this a top wine in 2023.
