## Château Puy-Razac Grand Cru St Emilion, 2019

Located at the foot of the famous 'Pavie' hillside, in the southern part of Saint-Emilion, Château Puy-Razac commands today a 6 hectare single-plot vineyard planted with Merlot (55%) for its delicate and subtle richness and Cabernet Franc (45%) that brings its explosive fruit and the necessary tannic backbone for wines with a great ability to age.

### Tasting Notes:

Once again Château Puy-Razac has produced another wonderful example of the wines they are able to produce from the southern part of St Emilion. The 2018 vintage is a beautiful and well structured wine. Dark red garnet in colour, with lovely aromas of rich red fruit. A well balanced and complex wine bursting with red fruit flavours and soft tannins. Powerful, tasty and elegant, with a long and balanced finish.
