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## Château Semonlon 2018, Haut-Médoc

Situated in the Haut-Médoc near Margaux, this sturdy petit-château claret is made from old vines, which grow on gravelly soil, and whose grapes are harvested by hand.

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### Tasting Notes:

Aged in 1 and 2 year old barrels sourced from the 4th Growth Grand Cru Classe, Château Prieuré-Lichine, there is a high proportion of Merlot in the blend for a Medoc. Bags of ripe plum fruits, this is a beautifully constructed wine with finely integrated tannins, a succulent mouthfeel and long, rich finish. A kind of Right Bank Left Bank sort of wine – if you know what I mean!
