The Clos Roquette Blanc is a Châteauneuf-du-Pape you can enjoy young. Medium bodied and aromatic - simply delicious!

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### Tasting Notes:

Wonderfully aromatic with white flowers, jasmine and flint on the nose. On the palate ripe with juicy stone fruit, a lovely bitterness and anise.

<b>Vinification</b>	Vines are planted on soil comprised of red clay and galets roulés. A leaner vintage, 2021 lent itself to whites with a more marked minerality than is typical for Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Harvested on a sunny morning in late August, grapes from La Roquette—equal parts Clairette, Roussanne, and Grenache Blanc. The wine ages in barrel for 8 months before bottling

The result is over 30 hectares of top Châteauneuf terroir with vines approaching full maturity, vinified in a modern winery.
