Vinification	Vines are planted on soil comprised of red clay and galets roulés. A leaner vintage, 2021 lent itself to whites with a more marked minerality than is typical for Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Harvested on a sunny morning in late August, grapes from La Roquette—equal parts Clairette, Roussanne, and Grenache Blanc. The wine ages in barrel for 8 months before bottling
