## **Tasting Notes:**

The vibrant and lifted nose keeps you going back for further exploration; pear, nectarine, jasmine and lemongrass. The palate is beautifully balanced with great natural acidity and a soft, creamy texture. The wine shows grilled pineapple, peach, lemon, fresh ginger and white pepper. This variety loves McLaren Vale's warm, Mediterranean climate which encourages wines of aromatic intensity and textural generosity.
