Produced from vines planted very close to the village of Meursault with an average age of 70 years. Aged in oak for 11 months. Fresh and lively with citrus notes and a wet stone minerality.

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### Tasting Notes:

Fresh and lively with citrus notes and a wet stone minerality that underpins a lovely rich fruit structure. Quenching and intense with a subtle note of walnut on the finish. What a great little wine!
