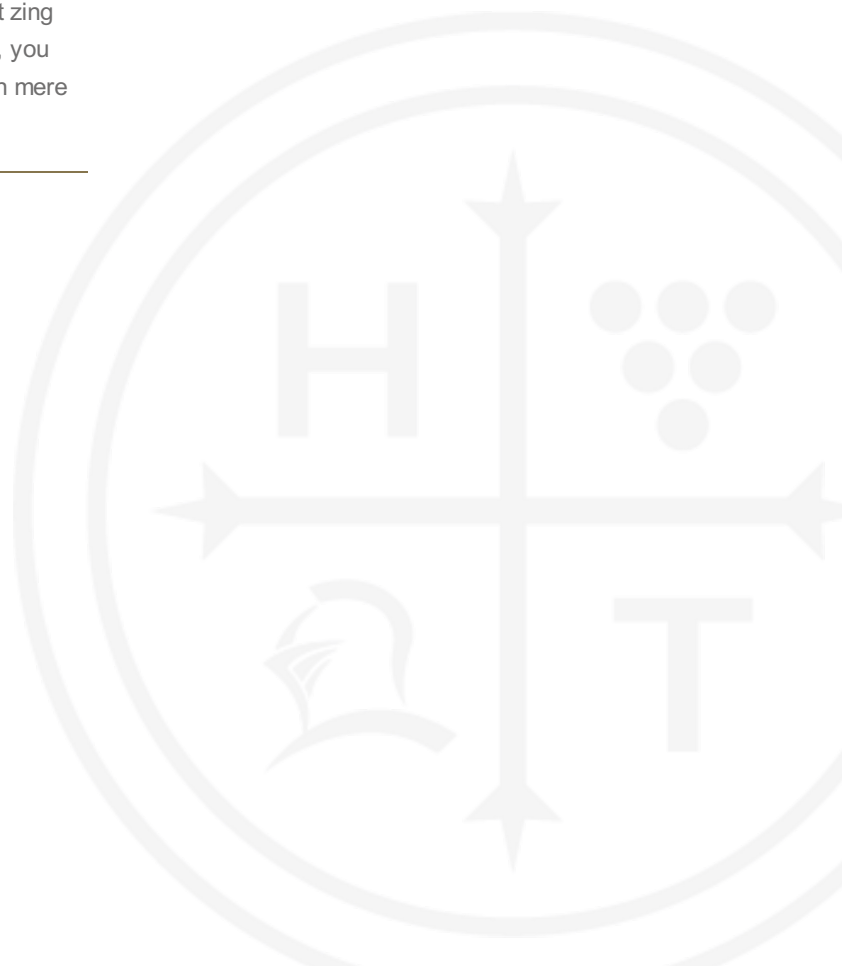
Produced from vines planted very close to the village of Meursault with an average age of 70 years. This is one of the finest 'value for money' wines.

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### Tasting Notes:

Stylish, fruit packed, with notes of tropical fruits, grapefruit zing and a wonderful textured, creamy mid palate. Tasted blind, you would believe this wine is from a far higher appellation than mere Coteaux Bourguignon.
