Groote Post is an historic 18th century farm on South Africa's west coast where the winemaking traditions have been revived by the Pentz family. This Sauvignon is fruit driven with a vibrant acidity and a hint of grass on the finish.

Tasting Notes:

On the nose aromas of white stone fruit with balanced minerality and a touch of asparagus. The palate has great length, showing green fig and gooseberry flavours.

Vinification	After sorting, destemming and crushing, 50% of the grapes had skin contact for 6 to 12 hours. Only the free-run juice were used for this wine. The wine was fermented in stainless steal tanks and left on the lees for 2 months.
