Nyetimber have the well-earned reputation of being English wine's top producer, and this delicious Blanc de Blancs demonstrates why. This superb home-grown sparkling wine has been known to challenge its French rivals in critic scores and blind tastings alike and is well worth a place in your cellar.

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### Tasting Notes:

Lovely pale gold in colour with a fine bead. This Blanc de Blancs shows Nyetimber's classic signature of delicate floral and citrus aromas followed by subtle vanilla and toast flavours, but now with a pure crystalline core thanks to the inclusion of Chardonnay from their Hampshire vineyards. A long complex finish makes this a wine to be savoured.
