Jeez! This is some wine! Rich, seductive, intense and beautifully balanced. This is a sensational wine full of chocolate, cherry liqueur and forest fruit flavours. Amazing!

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### Tasting Notes:

Intense from the very start, aromas of chocolate, cherry liqueur and forest fruits abound, with some spice – the palate continues with the same flavours, but adds a raspberry coulis layer that freshens and adds weight and structure. This is BIG wine in all senses, with a layer of chalkdust that hints at the minerality, a lovely fresh citric quality that adds life and overall an impression of deeply sweet, succulent and hedonistic fruit.
