The Demoiselles vineyard, lying to the northern edge of Montrachet and across from the 1er Cru of Pucelles, is owned by just 3 producers. It is arguably the finest of the 1er cru, and, for the sake of 9 feet of pathway and a small wall, could be Montrachet itself. Amiot's 0.25ha of 70 year old vines are wedged between the northern edge of the Grand Cru of Le Montrachet, and just below Chevalier-Montrachet.

Tasting Notes:

Big, powerful and opulent, this is a supremely complex wine full of runny honey richness balanced by a tight minerality. Outstanding!
