A lovely wine using the indigenous grape Aghiorghitiko and the more well known Cabernet Sauvignon varietal. Medium deep in colour, aromas of black cherries with hints of plum and herbs.

Tasting Notes:

The colour is brilliant, medium deep, violet with pink hues. On the nose it is vivid and intense with aromas of black cherries; blackberries coupled with hints of plum, violet and dried herbs. On the palate it has medium body, moderate acidity with smooth tannins, all in harmony. The aftertaste is moderate with a note of gentle aniseed.

Skouras Winery produces wine made from both indigenous and international varieties sourced from estate vineyards and regional growers.
