<b>Producer Overview</b>	Skouras Winery was created in 1986 by George Skouras who studied oenology in Dijon, France. The founding winery is located in Pyrgela, Argo with a second winery built in 1996 at Ghymno, Nemea, and in 2004 operations moved to a new winery in Malandreni. Skouras Winery produces wine made from both indigenous and international varietals sourced from estate vineyards and regional growers.
