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### Tasting Notes:

Bursting with red fruit. On the nose raspberry, red berry and strawberry. On the palate the fruit develops and bursts with a floral edge, aniseed and smoke. Sweet spicy cinnamon can be tasted as well as the bursting acidity from the red fruit.

<b>Vinification</b>	Carbonic Maceration is used on 65% on the grapes to enhance the fruit and floral quality of the wine. The other 35% are receive a warm traditional fermentation. They are combined and matured in French oak for nine weeks.
