<b>Press Comments</b>	Decanter June 2024, "Volnay's New Generation", 94 points: "This impressive wine is putatively the 'regular' Volnay (rather than the 2017 Vendanges Selectionnees bottling), but it is a lovely expression of the village, with a compelling delicious fruit character of black plums touched with exotic spice and earth. Supple and approachable, it's beginning to open nicely, and there is enough substance to carry it to a complex, lingering finish. The grapes are from six sites spread throughout the village, gently destemmed and fermented before ageing in mainly used casks. Delightful. Biodynamic."
