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## Volnay 'Vieilles Vignes' 2022, Domaine Voillot

Harvested from 6 separate plots that lie in front of the 1er cru of Champans, the 'vieilles vignes' average over 56 years old. An intense, ripe and fragrant Volnay.

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### Tasting Notes:

An Intense, ripe and polished Volnay, showing pedigree, power and structure. The wine is perfectly balanced between super-ripe fruit and fresh acidity, with an edge of pomegranate that foils the raspberry coulis and cherry liqueur flavours well. A touch of Parma violet gives interest, and the intensity remains throughout the long complex, tightening finish.

<b>Vinification</b>	Etienne started harvesting on the 27th August, some 3 weeks ahead of normal. After fermenting in tank, with regular pigeage, the wine finishes fermentation and is aged in 20% new oak for 12 months.
